The Airports Slot Allocation Regulation 2006

Notice of Financial Penalty to be paid by

GlobeAir AG for repeatedly and intentionally operating a flight significantly off slot from the allocated slot on 11 May 2016

Airport Coordination Limited (ACL), as the appointed coordinator for London Luton airport has the responsibility, inter alia, for the administration of the Misuse of Slots Enforcement Code 2007 (the Code), implemented at coordinated airports in the UK on 1 January 2007 in accordance with the Airport Slot Allocation Regulations 2006 (the UK Regulations).

ACL gave GlobeAir AG a Notice of Final Decision on 13 June 2016 which notified GlobeAir AG that pursuant to Regulation 16 of the UK Regulations, ACL had decided to impose a financial penalty on GlobeAir AG in respect of GlobeAir AG's repeated and intentional breach of regulation 14 of the UK Regulations which occurred on 11 May 2016.

Accordingly, ACL has imposed a financial penalty on GlobeAir AG in the amount of £1,000 (£1,000 x 1 operation).

GlobeAir is aware that further operations significantly off slot from the allocated slot may result in further financial penalties being applied.
