## The Airports Slot Allocation Regulation 2006

## Notice of Financial Penalty to be paid by

## BA CityFlyer for repeatedly and intentionally operating flights significantly off slot from the allocated slot between 7 May 2017 and 18 June 2017 (day 7), inclusive

Airport Coordination Limited (ACL), as the appointed coordinator for Stansted Airport has the responsibility for the administration of the Misuse of Slots Enforcement Code 2007 (the Code), implemented at coordinated airports in the UK on 1 January 2007 in accordance with the Airport Slot Allocation Regulations 2006 (the UK Regulations).

ACL gave BA CityFlyer a Notice of Final Decision on 15 August 2017 which notified BA CityFlyer that pursuant to Regulation 16 of the UK Regulations, ACL had decided to impose a financial penalty on BA CityFlyer in respect of BA CityFlyer's repeated and intentional breaches of regulation 14 of the UK Regulations which occurred on five occasions between the period 7 May 2017 to 18 June 2017 (day 7), inclusive.

Accordingly, ACL has imposed a financial penalty on BA CityFlyer in the amount of ACL is proposing to levy a sanction of £30,000 (£5,000 x six operations). BA CityFlyer is aware that further operations significantly off slot from the allocated slot may result in further financial penalties being applied.
