The Airports Slot Allocation Regulation 2006

Notice of Financial Penalty to be paid by

easyJet for repeatedly and intentionally operating three series flights significantly off slot from the allocated slot between 26 March 2017 and 2 July 2017, inclusive

Airport Coordination Limited (ACL), as the appointed coordinator for Gatwick Airport has the responsibility for the administration of the Misuse of Slots Enforcement Code 2007 (the Code), implemented at coordinated airports in the UK on 1 January 2007 in accordance with the Airport Slot Allocation Regulations 2006 (the UK Regulations).

ACL gave easyJet a Notice of Final Decision on 10 January 2018 which notified easyJet that pursuant to Regulation 16 of the UK Regulations, ACL had decided to impose a financial penalty on easyJet in respect of easyJet's repeated and intentional breaches of regulation 14 of the UK Regulations which occurred on five occasions between the period 26 March 2017 to 2 July 2017, inclusive.

Accordingly, ACL has imposed a financial penalty on easyJet in the amount of ACL is proposing to levy a sanction of £400,000 (EZY8621 £8,000 x 20 operations, EZY8199 £15,000 x 8 operations, EZY8258 £8,000 x 15 operations).

easyJet is aware that further operations significantly off slot from the allocated slot may result in further financial penalties being applied.
