The Airports Slot Allocation Regulation 2006

Notice of Financial Penalty to be paid by

Ryanair for repeatedly and intentionally operating flights significantly off slot on four occasions between 27 March 2017 and 20 May 2017

Airport Coordination Limited (ACL), as the appointed coordinator for Luton Airport has the responsibility for the administration of the Misuse of Slots Enforcement Code 2007 (the Code), implemented at coordinated airports in the UK on 1 January 2007 in accordance with the Airport Slot Allocation Regulations 2006 (the UK Regulations).

ACL gave Ryanair a Notice of Final Decision on 6 February 2018 which notified Ryanair that pursuant to Regulation 16 of the UK Regulations, ACL had decided to impose a financial penalty on Ryanair in respect of Ryanair's repeated and intentional breaches of regulation 14 of the UK Regulations which occurred on 4 occasions between the period 27 March 2017 and 20 May 2017.

Accordingly, ACL has imposed a financial penalty on Ryanair in the amount of £10,000 (£2,500 x four operations).
