## **Airport Coordination Limited**

## The Airports Slot Allocation Regulation 2006

## Notice of Financial Penalty to be paid by

British Airways for repeatedly and intentionally operating in a significantly different way on 38 occasions between 28 October 2018 and 1 December 2018, inclusive.

Airport Coordination Limited (ACL), as the appointed coordinator for Heathrow Airport has the responsibility, inter alia, for the administration of the Misuse of Slots Enforcement Code 2007 (the Code), implemented at coordinated airports in the UK on 1 January 2007 in accordance with the Airport Slot Allocation Regulations 2006 (the UK Regulations).

ACL gave British Airways a Notice of Final Decision on 20 March 2019 which notified British Airways that pursuant to Regulation 16 of the UK Regulations, ACL had decided to impose a financial penalty on British Airways in respect of British Airways repeated and intentional breach of regulation 14 of the UK Regulations which occurred on 38 occasions between 28 October 2018 and 1 December 2018, inclusive.

Accordingly, ACL has imposed a financial penalty on British Airways in the amount of £38,000. (38 operations x £1,000 per operation).

British Airways is aware that further operations in a significantly different way to that allocated at the time of operation may result in further financial penalties being applied.
