The Airports Slot Allocation Regulation 2006

Notice of Financial Penalty to be paid by

Tunisair for failure to respond to requests from ACL for slot monitoring queries during the winter 2018 scheduling period.

Airport Coordination Limited (ACL), as the appointed coordinator for Heathrow Airport has the responsibility, inter alia, for the administration of the Misuse of Slots Enforcement Code 2007 (the Code), implemented at coordinated airports in the UK on 1 January 2007 in accordance with the Airport Slot Allocation Regulations 2006 (the UK Regulations).

ACL gave Tunisair a Notice of Final Decision on 9 April 2019 which notified Tunisair that pursuant to Regulation 16 of the UK Regulations, ACL had decided to impose a financial penalty on Tunisair in respect of Tunisair's failure to respond to ACLs request for information.

Accordingly, ACL has imposed a financial penalty on Tunisair in the amount of £8,000.

Tunisair is aware that further failures to respond to requests for information may result in further financial penalties being applied.
