The Airports Slot Allocation Regulation 2006

Notice of Financial Penalty to be paid by

Air India for failure to respond to requests from ACL for slot monitoring queries during the winter 2018 scheduling period.

Airport Coordination Limited (ACL), as the appointed coordinator for Birmingham Airport has the responsibility, inter alia, for the administration of the Misuse of Slots Enforcement Code 2007 (the Code), implemented at coordinated airports in the UK on 1 January 2007 in accordance with the Airport Slot Allocation Regulations 2006 (the UK Regulations).

ACL gave Air India a Notice of Final Decision on 24 April 2019 which notified Air India that pursuant to Regulation 16 of the UK Regulations, ACL had decided to impose a financial penalty on Air India in respect of Air India's failure to respond to ACLs request for information.

Accordingly, ACL has imposed a financial penalty on Air India in the amount of £8,000.

Air India is aware that further failures to respond to requests for information may result in further financial penalties being applied.
