The Airports Slot Allocation Regulation 2006

Notice of Financial Penalty to be paid by

NetJets Europe for repeatedly and intentionally operating without an allocated slot on 5 September 2019.

Airport Coordination Limited (ACL), as the appointed coordinator for London City Airport has the responsibility, inter alia, for the administration of the Misuse of Slots Enforcement Code 2007 (the Code), implemented at coordinated airports in the UK on 1 January 2007 in accordance with the Airport Slot Allocation Regulations 2006 (the UK Regulations).

ACL gave NetJets Europe a Notice of Final Decision on 21 October 2019 which notified NetJets Europe that pursuant to Regulation 16 of the UK Regulations, ACL had decided to impose a financial penalty on NetJets Europe in respect of NetJets Europe repeated and intentional breach of regulation 14 of the UK Regulations which occurred on 5 September 2019.

Accordingly, ACL has imposed a financial penalty on NetJets Europe in the amount of £4,000. (1 operation x £4,000 per operation).

NetJets Europe is aware that further operations without an allocated slot may result in further financial penalties being applied.
