

Dubai World Central Airport Positioning, Training and Technical Stop Flights Local Rule

Dubai World Central (DWC) has been temporarily designated as IATA Level 3 during the period of United Nations Climate Change Conference (COP28) in Winter 2023 season between Tuesday 28 November 2023 and Thursday 14 December 2023. This move reflects increasingly scarce capacity and the intention to implement a scheduling process that can promote best utilisation of the capacity in these periods during the period of COP28.

ADDITIONAL SCHEDULING RULES AT DUBAI WORLD CENTRAL AIRPORT (DWC) FOR POSITIONING, TRAINING AND TECHNICAL STOP OPERATIONS:

Positioning flights (IATA SSIM Chapter 6 service type P) are not permitted at Dubai World Central Airport during the period of COP28 in Winter 2023 season.

Training flights (IATA SSIM Chapter 6 service types T & K) are not permitted at Dubai World Central Airport during the period of COP28 in Winter 2023 season.

Technical Stop operations (IATA SSIM Chapter 6 service type X) are not permitted at Dubai World Central Airport during the period of COP28 in Winter 2023 season.

*Technical Stop operations related to flights approved via local diplomatic channels are exempt from these restrictions.
