## The Airports Slot Allocation Regulation 2006

## Notice of Financial Penalty to be paid by

## easyJet for repeatedly and intentionally operating an significantly off slot from the allocated slot on 26 April 2015

Airport Coordination Limited (ACL), as the appointed coordinator for Stansted and London Luton airport has the responsibility, inter alia, for the administration of the Misuse of Slots Enforcement Code 2007 (the Code), implemented at coordinated airports in the UK on 1 January 2007 in accordance with the Airport Slot Allocation Regulations 2006 (the UK Regulations).

ACL gave easyJet a Notice of Final Decision on 22 May 2015 which notified easyJet that pursuant to Regulation 16 of the UK Regulations, ACL had decided to impose a financial penalty on easyJet in respect of easyJet's repeated and intentional breach of regulation 14 of the UK Regulations which occurred on 26 April 2015 at both Stansted and London Luton airport.

Accordingly, ACL has imposed a financial penalty on easyJet in the amount of  $\pounds$ 12,000 ( $\pounds$ 6,000 x two operations, one at Stansted airport and the reciprocal operation at London Luton airport).

easyJet is aware that further operations significantly off slot from the allocated slot may result in further financial penalties being applied.
