The Airports Slot Allocation Regulation 2006

Notice of Financial Penalty to be paid by

TUIfly Germany for repeatedly and intentionally operating an aircraft without an allocated slot on 19 December 2015

Airport Coordination Limited (ACL), as the appointed coordinator for London Luton airport has the responsibility, inter alia, for the administration of the Misuse of Slots Enforcement Code 2007 (the Code), implemented at coordinated airports in the UK on 1 January 2007 in accordance with the Airport Slot Allocation Regulations 2006 (the UK Regulations).

ACL gave TUIfly Germany a Notice of Final Decision on 22 April 2016 which notified TUIfly Germany that pursuant to Regulation 16 of the UK Regulations, ACL had decided to impose a financial penalty on TUIfly Germany in respect of TUIfly Germany's repeated and intentional breach of regulation 14 of the UK Regulations which occurred on 19 December 2015.

Accordingly, ACL has imposed a financial penalty on TUIfly Germany in the amount of £1,000.

TUIfly Germany is aware that further operations without an allocated slot may result in further financial penalties being applied.
